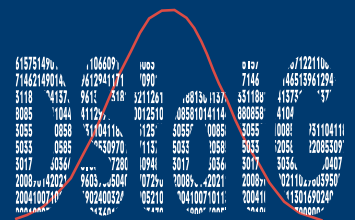
Young statisticians giving a lecture at 2010 Annual Meeting may apply for a grant covering travelling allowances. Details can be found on the Society's homepage.
